As part of the Management Commitment to Airworthiness Safety it is a prime objective of the company to retain accreditation and comply with the AS9100 Procedures and associated specifications.

Only parts that conform to the customers design definition or industry standard parts shall be purchased from approved stockists and manufacturers, who hold as a minimum a quality management system accreditation to ISO 9001, ensuring full traceability for make up and origin of components.

The Company operates a no blame culture and encourages everyone to be vigilant and highlight to Management anything that may have an effect on Airworthiness Safety, this includes methods of manufacture, operator errors, lack of training or evidence of processes or procedures not being followed including any suspect unapproved parts that are received.

This Airworthiness Safety Policy encompasses the requirements and legislation for Health & Safety, Conflict Minerals, Code of Conduct & Business Ethics, Environmental, Customer and Government, and it is the duty of everyone in the Company to work to these rules and regulations.
