Management Commitment

The Management Team is committed to ensuring that:

- All employees working on aerospace products have sufficient experience and appropriate training.
- All tooling, fixtures, and measuring equipment meet customer and industry requirements, are safe to use, and are calibrated to national standards where required.
- Accreditation is retained, and full compliance is maintained with AS9100 procedures, associated specifications, and any applicable customer-specific requirements.

Procurement & Traceability

Only parts that conform to customer design definitions or recognized industry standards will be purchased. These shall only be sourced from approved distributors and manufacturers who, at a minimum, hold ISO 9001 certification, ensuring full traceability of the components' origin and makeup.

Safety Culture

Copper & Optic Terminations Ltd operates a no-blame culture and encourages all employees to be vigilant and report to management anything that may affect Airworthiness Safety. This includes:

- Methods of manufacture
- Operator errors
- Insufficient training
- Evidence of non-compliance with processes or procedures
- Suspect or unapproved parts received
